

Out-Patients

An urgent OP appt can be arranged by completing an urgent referral form (central area cabinet) or ideally by dictating a letter to the referring specialty. A tape machine is available near Bay 1.

Ultrasound – The requests are made on the blue radiology forms. Patients with musculo-skeletal conditions are usually followed up in the Accident & Emergency Returns Clinic. For follow-up Ultrasounds of abdomen and pelvis for Urological or Gynecological conditions are usually followed up in their respective out-patients. You should clearly mark the request for the report to go to these destinations.

The department is developing its own expertise in ultrasound scanning for specific conditions. See section C for further information or ask Mr Sloan.

Bone Scans – Requested on the same blue radiology form. These are usually followed up in the Returns Clinic in the Accident & Emergency Department.

Miscellaneous - EEG, EMG, Ambulatory 24hr ECG monitoring etc – Appropriate forms can be found in the cabinets placed in the Central Area.
